

How to Have a Good Relationship with Your Parents Discussion Questions “The Edge” Wednesday, January 6, 2010

Read Ephesians 6:1-3 together and answer the following questions.

1. What two commands does the Lord give children in this passage?
2. What does it mean to obey your parents “in the Lord”?
3. Is there ever a time that you **should not** obey me?
4. Talk about why it is so hard for parents and teenagers to get along sometimes (selfishness and pride are part of the reason).
5. Discuss the following statement: “When you fight against your parents, you are really fighting against God”.
6. Jesus obeyed His Father all the way to the cross. Parents, share a time in your life where you obeyed your parents even though at the time you may not of wanted to, but looking back on it now, you see that it was the best thing to do.
7. Parents, share with your student something that they could do for you that would really show you honor. Pray together as a family that God would really help the parents fulfill their role and help the students to obey, honor, and trust them.
